2. **Financial Transmission Mechanism:** Articulates how an event may impact company revenues, profit margins, supply-chain balance, valuations, or asset pricing.
3. **Investor Centricity:** Seeks to address key investor questions (e.g., primary beneficiaries, risk exposure, second-order impacts, and critical operational metrics).
4. **Factual and Evidentiary Basis:** Anchored primarily in official disclosures, regulatory filings, or recognized financial data sources.
5. **Information Increment & Non-Duplication:** Strives to deliver distinct added value (such as new data interpretation, peer asset comparisons, or novel logical frameworks) rather than simply repeating third-party media coverage.

4. SOURCING & VERIFICATION STANDARDS

Our editorial team follows a multi-tier sourcing architecture designed to prioritize primary and verifiable origins over unconfirmed secondary reports:
